



①To go to Tamura city by using Tohoku Shinkansen(東北新幹線/とうほくしんかんせん) and Banetsutousen Line(磐越東線/ばんえつとうせん)

Take Tohoku Shinkansen from Tokyo Station(東京駅/とうきょうえき)bound for Koriyama/ Sendai/ Yamagata and get off at Koriyama station(郡山駅/こおりやまえき). It will take about one hour and twenty minutes to get to Koriyama station from Tokyo.

After that, take Banetsutousen Line bound for Ononiimachi/ Iwaki and get off at Funehiki station. It will take about 25 minutes to get to Funehiki station(船引駅/ふねひきえき).

②To go to Tamura city by taking Joban Line (常磐線/じょうばんせん) and Banetsutousen Line (磐越東線/ばんえつとうせん)

Take Joban Line from Ueno Station(上野駅/うえのえき)bound for Iwaki and get off at Iwaki station. It will take about two hours and fifteen minutes to get to Iwaki station (いわき駅/いわきえき).

After that, take Banetsutousen Line bound for Koriyama and get off at Funehiki station(船引駅/ふねひきえき). It will take about one hour and ten minutes to get to Funehiki station.

OTaking airplane. (Only from Itami Airport or Shinchitose Airport)

Go to Fukushima airport(福島空港/ふくしまくうこう) by airplane

From Fukushima airport, it will take about one hour drive for you to arrive at the main municipal building of Tamura City. (There is no direct bus service from Fukushima airport to Tamura City.)

If you take the bus, you can get on a limousine bus from Fukushima airport to Koriyama station (郡山駅/こおりやまえき). It will take about forty five minutes until you arrive at Koriyama station. It costs 1120 yen, single trip.

You will need to take JR Line from Koriyama station to Funehiki station (船引駅/ふねひきえき).
